UNDERSTANDING YOUR BILL

Energy Charges

Delivery System

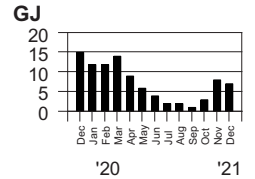

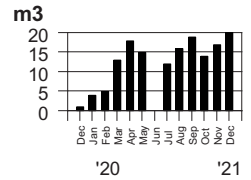

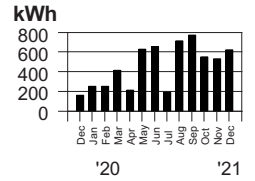
